# Talk to God

Spend some time inviting the Holy Spirit to reveal and help you identify answers to the following questions.

- What areas in your life do you feel resigned or stuck in? Why?
- How have the places you are stuck in become part of your identity? How does this contrast what God's Word says about your identity in Christ?
- Are there ways you feel like you are missing out in your faith? In what ways?
- Where do you feel God is moving you from and to in this season of your life?
- What keeps you from trusting and obeying God?
- What role has the enemy of fear and discouragement kept you from God's promised rest for your life?

## **APPLICATION**

What attributes of God do you want to get to know and better understand in this season of life?

His provision? His faithfulness? His love? Knowing God moves you to trust God to the life He has promised YOU.

Who are your go-to people for accountability and prayer? *Invite them in to where you want God to move you to and from in this season.* 

Do you know what your identity in Christ is? Spend some time in God's Word discovering who you are according to the one who made you.

What is God's purpose for your life according to scripture and what He has revealed to you in your faith journey so far? Spend some time seeking this out through Scripture and write it out on an index card. Put it on your bathroom mirror.

What is the great invitation Jesus is inviting you to every day, every hour, and sometimes minute by minute?

Memorize Matthew 11:28-30.

#### ACTS 17:28-29 (MSG)

The God who made the world and everything in it, this Master of sky and land, doesn't live in custom-made shrines or need the human race to run errands for him, as if he couldn't take care of himself. He makes the creatures; the creatures don't make him. ## about moving forward

- Job 17:9 The righteous keep moving forward, and those with clean hands become stronger and stronger.
- Philippians 3:14 I run straight toward the goal to win the prize that God's heavenly call offers in Christ Jesus.
- Proverbs 4:18 The way of the righteous is like the first gleam of dawn, which shines ever brighter until the full light of day.

## about my past

- Isaiah 43:18 Forget what happened in the past, and do not dwell on events from long ago.
- Philippians 3:13 Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead.
- Romans 8:1 Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.
- 1 John 1:8-9 If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

#### about trusting in God

- Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.

## about wisdom + guidance from God

- Isaiah 58:11 The LORD will guide you continually, giving you water when you are dry and restoring your strength. You will be like a well-watered garden, like an everflowing spring.

# SCRIPTURE ON MOVING FORWARD

## about God's Word directing me

- Psalm 1:2-3 Instead he finds pleasure in obeying the Lord's commands; he meditates on his commands day and night. He is like a tree planted by flowing streams; it yields its fruit at the proper time, and its leaves never fall off. He succeeds in everything he attempts.
- Psalm 119:104-105 I obtain understanding from your precepts; therefore, I hate every false way. Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light for my pathway.
